As part of the affiliate network of the National Association for the Education of Young Children (NAEYC), the undersigned organizations are committed to ensuring that all children are able to thrive and learn in a society dedicated to ensuring they reach their full potential. We shared the national organization's [strong opposition to children being separated from their parents at the U.S. border](#), because research is clear that those actions harm children's development and well-being. Yet while family separation has been ended, children are still being harmed.

We stand together now to implore a continued and urgent focus on the children who have yet to be reunited with their parents, as well as to advocate for a solution that does not involve incarcerating children. Research tells us that family detention harms kids. Our core values tell us that we have an obligation to strengthen the bonds between all children and their families. Therefore, we are speaking out on this critical issue to respond to the research, advance that obligation and uphold our core values. We recognize the power of our individual and collective voices, and will continue to act to address this and the many other issues and opportunities facing our children, families, and educators today and every day.
